WAR MEMORIAL LIBRARY RENOVATION!

Southside Neighborhood Association featured an in-depth presentation of the restoration of the Pine Street library by Preservation Architect Elise Johnson-Schmidt at the November Annual Meeting. With managing partner Craig Marlatt, Elise shared plans for repurposing the Library to house five apartments and an office retaining historic features such as fireplaces and woodwork. Construction is currently underway, and the developers expect completion as soon as fall 2013

In 1930, the citizens of Corning raised \$75,000 to restore the old City Club into a city library and memorial to those who died in WWI. The following year, Frederick Carder designed a window featuring his Bristol yellow glass and honoring the loss of the 30 young men from Corning, including his son Cyril. The window was placed over the main entrance as part of the memorial. The window was removed and a permanent viewing site is being explored by the city Public Art Committee.

We all look forward to seeing the project come to fruition and this wonderful historic memorial structure restored.
